## KEAN QUEST ANNOUNCES WINNERS OF VOCAL COMPETITION Gabby Barrett wins Kean Quest 2014

GIBSONIA, Pa. (Richland Twp.), April 14, 2014 – The Kean Theatre was abuzz with excitement for the return of **Jackie Evancho**. Coming full circle, **Evancho** went from performing on the Kean Theatre stage as a Kean Quest contestant in 2008 and 2009 to presenting an award in her honor and serving as a guest judge.

When asked if she had any advice for the contestants performing in the 2014 Kean Quest Talent Search Youth Finale on Friday, April 11, Jackie addressed the finalists stating, "I enjoyed each and every performance and I can't stop smiling – thank you all!"

Gabby Barrett of Pittsburgh won the 2014 Kean Quest Talent Search title, impressing the judges with her rendition of "Mercy." She was accompanied on the guitar by Jason Novak, and won a recording package with Grammy award-winning studio Audible Images. Gabby is an eighth grade student at St. Teresa's and received the Audience Choice award in the semi-final round of the competition. Her performance in the finale received the top combined score of the four judges out of the 29 contestants performing during the Youth Finals.

**Jake Pederson** of Gibsonia won the **Audience Choice** award with his performance of "All of Me" by John Legend. The Pine-Richland High School freshman played the piano and sang – receiving the most votes from the audience – winning the second recording package with Audible Images. Jake was also the Audience Choice winner in the first preliminary round of the competition.

Standing on the stage where she gave her first public performance, Evancho presented Maura Yates of Franklin Park with the fourth annual "Jackie Evancho Award." The award is presented to a contestant who has competed in Kean Quest for two or more years, works hard, and never gives up no matter what the outcome is of the competition.

The Youth Finale of the 2014 Kean Quest Talent Search capped off the 11<sup>th</sup> season of the four month fundraising competition that began in January.
